This is where you import the pictures and do everything that's boring like keywords and collections It might be boring, but a little bit here will pay in space later on down the road, You'll see. You can sleep at night knowing that all your photos are safely blocked away with labels so you can get them to a rabbit beat. When you get a bit more experienced, you'll also find that most of this can be automated. Developing the modilThis is where the part in after everyone has left the library. The developed module is where you take these dull images and turn them into works of art. This is your digital room (Lightroom) where you can be creative. A lot of this can also be automated if you are in a hurry. But you may want to hang out here for a while, because this is fun! Light workflowOk, here we go. In some words as possible, here is how they work in light. I'll give you details of the thing that really matters and skip the boring details. Find your pictures in Lightroom You will start in the Library module: Click the import button in below left the import will open. Click the arrow in the lower left corner to expand it. It's useless you fall this is what the expanded Importer window looks like. Don't worry about all the options for now, we'll walk through the steps you need. See on the top and you'll see 3 options for the import workflow.: 1. Grab Photos from | 2. What to Do With Them | 3. Copy pictures For a location to look at the top and you will see from This is where we grab the bearing picture from Source LightroomUnder, you will see all your drives. You can bring them to your computer if you like, but for the sake of this tutorial, I'll assume that you want to bring them to your camera camera reader. Click this option (EOS\_DIGITAL is mine.) Note: If you can't see the pictures in your subfolders, click the panel that says to and select the Insert Subfolders option at the bottom of middle header, select an option to import. Copy and Copy as DNG are the only options from a camera or card. To keep it simple, we'll use Copy.At the top right, you'll see an option that says THIS TO is where we are copying the pictures (and videos) of. Under the To option, I recommend selecting the subfolder and in one Folder option and giving it a name. (this will prevent these terrible files banned by date, which is a pested later on) Next, find the folder that you want to insert your pictures. If you're just starting, it's a good idea to have a strategy and stick with it, because you'll be using this structure for a very long time. What should I do for a digital asset management strategy? What we are doing now, will create a folder structure on your disk drive. Dirty light doesn't care where the photos are nicely their catalog. But this structure is for you, to help you keep your pictures organized, trust me, it's worth the extra effort. I normally create a top level folder called pictures. Under this a created category that I will use like: PlacesPeopleEventsClientsetI will then create files as I import pictures under these categories, subcategories: PlacesBostonCaliforniaNew YorkLondonetcUse whatever category you think you'll need. You can still add more later or change yoWARNING! If you rename folder or image location, do it in lights or you will break the file association. In other words, if you switch somewhere in light, the image is moving onto your computer = good! If you move it directly on your computer, Lightroom won't know where it is = bad! Ok, back on Track, I think you need that bit of extra information if you are new to DAM (Digital Management Aka Manage Your Pictures) Choose a folder where you want your pictures to go toYou has now set up: Where from &gt; What to do with Pictures &gt; Where to go in main window, select the added pictures in light. Usually you'll go with the default, which is all the pictures on the map. If you turn on the option Do not import suspicious duplicates and pictures are already in light, they will be gray out. Clicking on the buttonYour pictures will now be copied to light and you'll return to the Library module where you can watch your picture getting sucked into Lightroom.All your pictures are now safely blocked in light. Next step will get them. Organize your photos into lightroomAt the top let you'll see the Navigator that is a thumbnail of the selected picture. Under that is the Catalog. The options that you'll use are either Previous Import, which will limit the view to just the last batch of photos you bought in Lightroom. Or you can select All Pictures, to display each picture now in light. If picture seems to be missing, click all picture.blocks at next down to display the Folder view. You'll see a list of leads that contain pictures of them that light is managed (in the Library). Now attached driving are lifted. The Folders structure is the same as on your computer, because this is what you're actually browsing now. Here you can see our file called Colorado that we just did when we imported from the map. Lightroom collections are goodWe want to make our own folder structure just for light, this will make things easier to use for us. For this, we use Collections. Collections have tons of advantages because they don't actually have pictures, just a reference to the pictures, this way we can have the same picture in different collections without making multiple copies of the same picture. Trust me, multiple copies of the same picture are something bad and can get very confusing as quickly filling up your drive with duplicate pictures. Select all of the pictures that you want to include in the collection. Click in the grid and press Cmd / Ctrl + A to select all. Click the + button and select Create Collection as shown. Name of this collection something that is descriptive. Optional: Nest it in an optional collection set. Check the box, Insert selected pictures. Click createBang! You now have a Collection with your selected picture in it. For way more reasons than I'll list here, like to organize my pictures into Collections and work on them from there. I almost never went to View Folder unless I lost something. Metadata in LightroomNow its time to perform all the metadata tasks. At a minimum done, I add some keywords to help find the pictures later. You can select an entire collection and add simple keywords to all in just a few seconds. You'll see little badges on pictures that contain metadata. There are a lot of other metadata things you can do in your photos right now if you like. If you want to sort through them and find these good ones, you can use things like ratings, flags and labels. I was touching on this on the 15 minute video, so you can watch that when you're ready to do more organization. When you want to go more advanced you can add meta data on import etc. You can even create metadata models that add a ton of information to a picture in a single click. (All of this is explained in my 13 training video Complete Lightroom) let's choose a picture and have some fun with it, enough of this organizational thing. Click a picture of the Filmstrip. It will be displayed beautiful and large if you double click on it. Using the Develop module of the word LightroomClick Developed at the top of light and the currently selected picture will now appear in the dark digital room. This is where you make all the image adjustment that could be as simple as crops, lighting or dark pictures or as advanced as locating dogs with burns, black and white, special effects and even returns. Once again, cover in depth of my light for digital video training and also some free tutorial here on PhotoshopCAFE. The ModuleLet developers make some adjustment to the picture. Here I grabbed the white balance tool and clicked on an area that would be completely gray or white in the picture. This removes the flow helme. White balance is usually the first thing I do in a picture. At this point, make some adjustment using the basic adjustment panel. Most of your adjustment can be made in this panel and it's certainly a good place to get started. There are a ton of other options that you will learn later as you go deeper into the rabbit hole. For now, just get familiar with basic adjustment. If you have used Raw Camera before in Photoshop, these settings are identical. Why bathroom? In it's most basic, the Library module. Then grab highlights and shading to recover details of highlighting and shading (Increase the dynamic range). Wear white and Black to contrast to the picture. Beautiful white clean bow with deep rich shade. Here is the result of moving a few backstage, a much more realistic picture and cleaner. Now is capable of more than just basic adjustment, you can use it to create a lot of attitude and drama, You can add colors alike and be very creative with Lightroom, and I will teach you that on other tutorials. The lightroom presetsWhat you can also make is save all these changes as presets. Presets are like little recipes that can be applied to any picture in a single click. You can make your own, or add in them that you get from others. Saving a presetClick on the + on the Preset panel will see the New Developers Preset panel. Give it a name and a folder, default Preset User Id. Note you can choose which adjustments are included in the preset. Most of the time, I add them all even if some settings are not in the preset, it won't cause any harm. Click Create and your preset will be saved. You can get it in the preset panel and use it anytime without having to re-apply all the adjustment. Here is the same picture where I applied some presets that I created at an earlier time. See how to dramatically change the appearance of a picture in a single click. A lot of people find Lightroom just to use presets. We'll email you some free presets and a free ebook to get you started now. Or here is a

completely different preset for a different feel in this picture. Exporting photos from LightroomWhen you ended up making your adjustment, you'll want to share your photos with the world. While you can create web galleries, slideshows, print and even make books in the different modules in Lightroom, let's do a simple job. Export a picture that we can share online on Social Media. (Lightroom can also be integrated with your favorite social media site directly from Within Light) Let's look at a simple photo export. Select File &gt;ExportYou will see the Export Range dialog box. There are a ton of options in here including the option to create preset export with multiple images. I actually created a Facebook preset, ill break it down. File image format selects jpg with an average quality. I limited the size to 1600 on longer corners, that's big enough for people to enjoy without getting so big it bog down the whole internet. I also include a watermark. I think it's always a good idea to protect your public image and watermarks. They also make it possible for people to find the copyright holder (you) when they are hot linked on different pages. Click export and the picture will be exported for your use.
